# Activating the Kaltura Ssogroupsync Feature in Kaltura MediaSpace (KMS)

Kaltura Ssogroupsync (https://knowledge.kaltura.com/help/ssogroupsync) is managed by KMS system administrators in the Admin area accessed from /admin (e.g. https://videos.mediaspace.kaltura.com/admin)

**NOTE:** Recommendation: When expecting a large amount of groups per user (in the hundreds), the first login for a user will be longer due to the synchronization of large amount of groups. In order to make a faster first login time we recommend a pre-launch groups creation using the a-sync group creation. ## Configure Kaltura Ssogroupdsync in KMS

### To enable the Ssogroupsync module in KMS

- 1. Login to KMS and go to the Kaltura Configuration Management window.
- 2. Scroll down and select the Ssogroupsync (https://knowledge.kaltura.com/help/ssogroupsync) module in the Modules section.

  The Ssogroupsync (https://knowledge.kaltura.com/help/ssogroupsync) Administration page is displayed.
- 3. In the Enabled field, select Yes to enable the Ssogroupsync (https://knowledge.kaltura.com/help/ssogroupsync) module.
- 4. Select or enter values for the relevant fields. This module ensures that SSO attribute's containing multi valued attributes use each of the values when syncing the groups to Kaltura.
- 5. Repeat to Add Value Mapping or Add Privileges. Delete as necessary for your configurations.
- 6. Click Save.

Enabled	Enable the Ssogroupsync module.	
Privileges		
add privilege	The SSO privilege name	
valueMappingType	Select the method in which KMS will handle the SSO groups' names. You can choose to use the values of the privilege to become the name of a group, or can map new group names to each value.	



Field	There are two options to add attributes.  Description  • Use privilege's value as group name
	Map privilege's value to a group name
	Depending on which option you choose, enter the Value of the SSO privilege or the Value of the SSO privilege and the SSO group name.
removeFromGroups	Select 'Yes' to allow the removal of users from groups previously synced with this module.
createNewGroups	Select 'Yes' to create new groups automatically. If 'No' is selected, manual creation of groups is needed for users to be added.
Valid	Module is configured well and ready to use.

#### **Additional Information**

- Remove from groups Allows admins to remove users from groups previously synced with this module. If the Group is removed or the group name is changed, and the removeFromGroups field is set to Yes, the group name change or removal will be implemented on the next login. If the removeFromGroups field is set to No, and you save, the user will not be removed from groups, only added on the next KMS login.
- Create New Groups Allows admins to create new groups automatically from the existing SSO groups. If 'No' is selected, you will need to manually create groups to add users.
- **Valid** The Valid field is used to verify the values entered. If the values are valid the field is displayed as Yes. For invalid values, the field is displayed as No with a relevant error message.
- User will have to login to KMS/KAF for the changes to take effect.
- Group IDs should be constructed of English alphabet and numbers only. It cannot contain spaces.
