

# Kaltura Video Quiz Canvas Gradebook User Guide

This article describes how to create an assignment that uses Kaltura's Video Quiz feature and integrates with the Canvas Gradebook.

## To create an assignment using Kaltura's Video Quiz (VQ) that integrates with the Canvas Gradebook

1. Create a video quiz in your My Media – See [How to create a Quiz with VQ](https://knowledge.kaltura.com/help/kaltura-video-editing-tools-quiz-tab). (<https://knowledge.kaltura.com/help/kaltura-video-editing-tools-quiz-tab>)
2. In a course go to the Assignments tab.
3. Add a new assignment.


**NOTE:** In using KAF/LMS integration, in order for quiz scores to pass to the LMS gradebook, you must launch the quiz from the **Assignments** tab. If a quiz is launched from a Course Gallery, the quiz score **will not** pass to the gradebook. Only quizzes launched from **Assignments** will pass grades.

4. **Do not add any Kaltura content in the text-editor.** You may add text or any other attachments.
5. Select submission type “External Tool”.

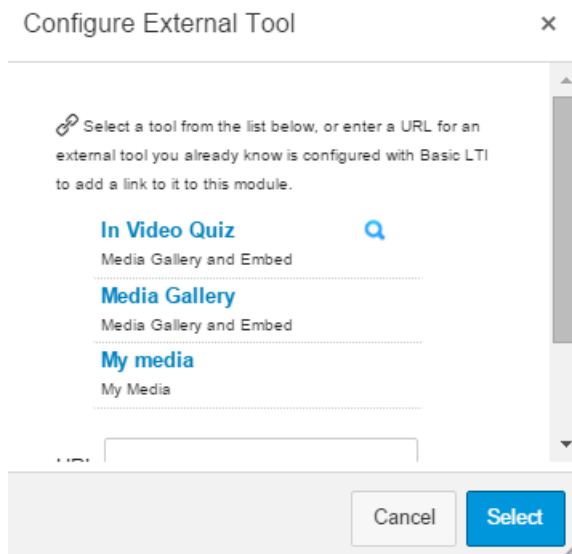

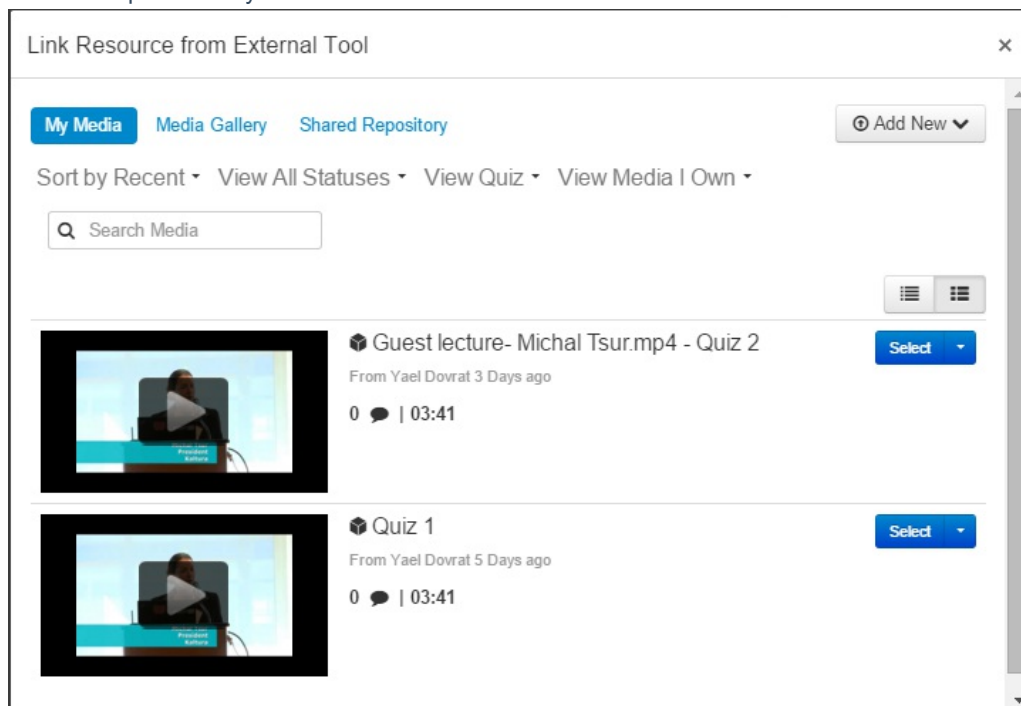

6. Click "Find", a pop up will appear.
7. Select the In Video Quiz tool (or the new tool name you configured).



8. Select a quiz from My Media.



9. Click Select again in the Configure External Tool Window.

10. Save and publish the assignment.
