### Adminembed

This is a custom module that allows users to generate KMC-like embed codes. Also supports embed code generation for Interactive Video entries.

## Annoto

**⚠** To configure the Annoto module, make sure you have the key and secret that you received from Annoto.

This module adds Annoto support to the Kaltura players, and Annoto Analytics to channels/media galleries. It applies to both KAF and KMS integrations.

Name	Description
enabled	Set to <b>Yes</b> to enable the module.
apiKey	API Key provided by Annoto for your site.
ssoSecret	Single Sign On secret matching the API Key provided by Annoto for your site.
disableDeprecatedOptions	Set to <b>Yes</b> to disable all deprecated options. When <b>Yes</b> is selected, all old settings are removed, and control is contained in the Annoto dashboard via the Annoto Preferences. To support backward compatibility, select <b>No</b> . When <b>No</b> is selected, all "old" settings are also supported, but are marked as Deprecated. For more information, see <a href="#">DEPRECATED options</a> .
activatedByDefault	[DEPRECATED] Field only displays when disableDeprecatedOptions is set to <b>No</b> . If activatedByDefault is set to <b>Yes</b> , by default Annoto is active on all the media for all channels/Media Galleries. If activatedByDefault is set to <b>No</b> , channel/Media Gallery owners can control which channels/Media Galleries/media have Annoto activated.

## Newrow


The Newrow Module allows you to open a Real Time Room from the Kaltura Media

Gallery, User Private Room and from Newrow KAF by Kaltura Resource (Check Newrowkaf Module). The Newrow Live Room enables you to play Kaltura content in the room and automatically upload a recorded session to Kaltura.

<b>Name</b>	<b>Description</b>
<i>Enable</i>	Set “Yes” to enable the module.
<i>newrowBaseURL</i>	Enter “ <a href="https://smart.newrow.com/">https://smart.newrow.com/</a> ” if it is not entered automatically.
<i>newrowOpenInNewTab</i>	Set to “Yes” to automatically launch Newrow in a new tab. Launching the real time room in its own tab is the recommended experience. Set to “No” to launch Newrow as an embedded experience.
<i>domain</i>	Choose which domain should the meeting room URL be.
<i>enableLiveRoomButtonByDefault</i>	When set to “Yes”, the Launch Live Room button is displayed in all Channels/Media Galleries. This default setting can be overridden in the Channel/Media Gallery settings.
<i>enableUserPrivateLiveRoom</i>	if set to “Yes” then KMS private users are able to open their own personal Newrow room from the Header user menu.
<i>newrowAccountOwnerEmail</i>	Set the email address of the Kaltura account owner to align them with Newrow.
<i>allowedUsersOrRoles</i>	Who can launch Newrow private

	live room and enable live room in channels? if a role is selected, any role above it will also be allowed.
<i>overrideNewrowLogo</i>	If set to yes, the KMS logo will be used inside the Newrow application. Default is 'Yes'.
<i>enableMultiplePersonalRooms</i>	If set to yes, allowed user (depends on 'allowedUsersOrRoles' configuration) will be able to create and access multiple personal virtual rooms. The default is 'No'.

powtoonAPIKey	Enter the key you received from Powtoon.
powtoonAPISecret	Enter the secret you received from Powtoon.
powtoonItDepartmentEmail	Enter the email address of the account manager that users will contact if they encounter license issues.
